E. Tax Information

Both the student and the parent(s) are **required** to submit processed 2023 Federal Tax information. The only acceptable methods to submit tax information are listed below:

Direct Data Exchange – Directly import your 2023 IRS data into your 2025-2026 FAFSA by logging into <u>studentaid.gov</u> and select "Make Correction". This tool allows you to consent for the exchange of federal tax information into your FAFSA. The process enables the FAFSA to retrieve income and tax data directly from the IRS.

Keep in mind that if your parent's are married, but filed taxes separately, each parent will need to consent to use the direct data exchange.

Signed Copy of federal income tax return – Provide a SIGNED copy of your and your parent's 2023 1040 Federal Income Tax Return and Schedules 1-6.

IRS Tax Return Transcript – Submit your 2023 Tax Return Transcript. You can order the transcript by online at <u>irs.gov</u> or via automated telephone request by calling 1-800-908-9946. You may also complete IRS Form 4506-T and check mark box 6a. Please make sure you request an IRS Tax Return Transcript NOT the IRS Account Transcript.

Verification of Non-Filing Letter – If your parent(s) did not file 2023 taxes, and are not required to file taxes, then they must request a Verification of Non-Filing Letter from the IRS by submitting IRS Form 4506-T, check marking box 7.

Amended Taxes -- If the student or parent filed an amended 2023 IRS tax return, please submit your original 2023 IRS Tax Return Transcript and a signed copy of the 2023 IRS Form 1040X that was filed with the IRS.
