STUDENT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In order to participate in the CCP Program you must first become eligible through High School GPA **OR** Relative Coursework **OR** Test Scores.

- Ask your School Counselor (parent/guardian) to send your High School transcripts with ACT scores to NSCC or arrange to take the Accuplacer.

Now that you are Eligible for the program. NSCC requires course placement scores for Composition I, Math and Science. Students can use a combination of ACT or Accuplacer scores for Course Placement.
