



HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

Submit the "Intent to Participate" form to your H.S. You must secure permission from a legal guardian and a high school official before participating in the CCP Program

- ☐ **Apply** online at Northweststate.edu/apply-now
- ☐ Complete CCP Consent Form and Permission Slip-Online
- Request that your school counselor submits an official transcript to NSCC

Application Deadlines: Summer Term April 1st | Fall Term April 15th | Spring Term November 1st



ELIGIBILITY & NEXT STEPS

- □ You must become eligible to participate in the CCP Program through your GPA, test scores, and/or relevant coursework. Speak with your advisor and school counselor about this process. *See Back Page For Student Eligibility Requirements*
- ☐ Set up access to your MyNSCC account using your NSCC email.
- Online Learning Readiness Assessment (OLR)



GET READY FOR CLASSES

- Meet with your advisor to talk about course availability and your educational goals.
- Meet with your school counselor to make sure the classes you plan to take at NSCC fit into your high school schedule and graduation plan.
- ☐ Schedule your CCP classes with your High School Counselor or NSCC CCP Advisor.
- Check with your school counselor regarding your textbooks and required course materials.



STUDENT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In order to participate in the CCP Program you must first become eligible through High School GPA **OR** Relative Coursework **OR** Test Scores.

High School GPA to qualify for the CCP Program (If you are a Junior High Student and do not have a High School GPA, you must take the Accuplacer to become eligible for CCP)

- Ask your School Counselor to send your High School transcripts with ACT scores to NSCC or arrange to take the Accuplacer.
- Visit Northweststate.edu/Accuplacer to schedule a time to take the test on campus.

• Your High School may offer a yearly Accuplacer test. Check with your School Counselor on testing dates. If you missed the testing date at your high school or it's not provided please sign up to take the Accuplacer on campus.

Now that you are Eligible for the program. NSCC requires course placement scores for Composition I, Math and Science. Students can use a combination of ACT or Accuplacer scores for Course Placement.
